LADY BETH was rated on the inside, was roused near the five-sixteenths, came off the rail under a drive in upper stretch, pursued the top two in the final furlong and finished willingly to just miss the place while clear for the show. QUARREL stumbled two strides from the gate, was reserved at the rear, raced between foes in the two path on the turn, was roused inside the five-sixteenths and lacked the needed response. SENIOR PRANK was rated on the outside, went three wide while let out on the turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths, turned into upper stretch under a drive and also lacked the needed response.
