POPPY FLOWER chased just off the inside from mid pack, remained on hold untilset down angled out four to five wide into upper stretch, closed well outside to issue a challenge inside the final furlong and was just up in the last jump to the wire. BUBBLE ROCK established the front from the start and was under a firmhold three to four paths off the hedge down the backstretch through swift splits despite the rating, went three then two wide through the turn under wraps, took the inside route into upper stretch and had the field get busy when given a notch to work with near the eighth pole, got roused inside that station, dug in under a light drive and was nailed at the finish. AMY C (GB) three wide in pursuit, got let out spinning four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a driverunning on willingly to secure the show honors. BAY STORM just off the inside in pursuit, tucked inside through the turn and remained on hold continuing in the inside route into upper stretch, got roused nearing the eighth pole and ran onto the finish. GOIN' GOOD four then three wide in pursuit, got set down spinning three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. CLITHEROE (GB) stumbled at the start and was bumped by SARAH HARPER, who broke outwards, then got forced to steady briefly conceding four lengths to the front, chased just off the inside until tucked inside through the turn, took the inside route into upper stretch, tipped to the two path straightened away, stayed on one paced to the finish but was outfinished. MESSIDOR (IRE) chased four wide under reserve until let out angled seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid, got outkicked to the finish. SARAH HARPER broke out at the start bumping CLITHEROE, who had just stumbled, chased three then two wide, got let out spinning three wide at the head of the stretch, weakened in the drive.
