ARABIAN LION coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside in aim of the front, tucked inside through the turn and came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, swung three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take narrow command a furlong out, then edged away to the finish kept to task. DREW'S GOLD lunged at the break breaking forward despite it, vied briefly five wide before settling five then four wide in closest aim of the leader, tucked to the two path through the turn advancing to apply pressure on that rival from the outside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, took over command spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and was collared a furlong out, ran on willingly to chase the winner home safe for the place honors. GILMORE chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, ran on to procure the show honors well clear of the rest. FEDERAL JUDGE coaxed from the gate, vied briefly before emerging to show the way in hand three wide with six and a half furlongs to run, tucked to the two path briefly before taking the inside into the turn and came under steadily increased pressure to the outside, got placed to coaxing at the five-sixteenths in response, took the inside route into upper stretch displaced from the front, then weakened in the final furlong. GUN PILOT coaxed from the start, chased along the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, continued just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened. GENERAL JIM chased just off the inside until tucked inside at the nine-sixteenths, came under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, angled three to four wide into upper stretch and tired. VICTORY FORMATION coaxed from the gate, vied from the four path briefly then got eased off the pace five and a half furlongs from home, chased three then two wide through the turn in retreat, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. FORT WARREN chased two to three wide until tucked inside through the turn getting ridden along at the seven-sixteenths, took the inside route into upper stretch and made no impact. DARK VECTOR chased three wide until steadied and altered four wide at the nine-sixteenths getting placed to urging soon after to keep pace, went three to four wide into upper stretch and tired. ARMAN broke out a step at the start, chased two to three wide, began to backtrack midway on the turn, went three to four wide into upper stretch and was eased through to the finish.
