ARCANGELO saved ground just off the top pair into the first turn and lost some position into the backstretch tipping three paths off the inside, advanced mildly to regain what was lost seven furlongs from home settling back to be just off the pace once more, began another small advance five furlongs out and tucked inside with nine-sixteenths to go, was given a nudge midway on the turn and bid to be on near even terms with five-sixteenths remaining, traded a small bump and brush with NATIONAL TREASURE at the quarter pole before seizing command straightened away in the inside route into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, then began to drift out through to the finish seven paths despite being flashed the crop to the right side along with an active left rein but held safe even though giving away ground to the end. FORTE just off the inside through the first turn, raced four wide in pursuit from mid pack down the backstretch, tipped out five wide through the far turn coming under coaxing and being flashed the crop to the right side when drifting slightly at the three-eighths pole, went seven wide at the top of the stretch and offered up a mild kick closing belatedly to just get up for the place honors in the final jumps. TAPIT TRICE away last without incident, came under coaxing and chased just off the inside through the first turn before tipping five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked four wide at the nine-sixteenths and commenced a bid on the front stacking outside a trio just off the leader at that station, angled five wide into upper stretch, dug in offering up a mild bid but was collared in the final strides for the place honors and forced to settle for the show. HIT SHOW four then three wide through the opening turn, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch just off the top pair, tucked three wide into the far turn coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths between rivals among a quartet just off the leader, got nudged by ANGEL OF EMPIRE to the two path at the three-eighths, tipped three wide at the head of the stretch and kept on to dead heat with his main rival at the finish. ANGEL OF EMPIRE coaxed from the start, raced five then four wide through the first turn before tipping six paths off the inside down the backstretch, briefly tucked five then four wide into the far turn, came in three wide three furlongs from home and nudged HIT SHOW to the two path when placed to coaxing at that station, swung four wide into upper stretch and kept on to dead heat at the end for the last major share. NATIONAL TREASURE forwardly placed from the start, raced three wide into the first turn latched on the early leader to the outside, took over command with a mile and three-sixteenths remaining and tipped to the four path down the backstretch settling in hand into a comfortable rhythm, tucked briefly three wide before taking to the two path into the far turn, came under challenge from a quartet half a mile from home and patiently fended them off awaiting greater challenge, got one to his inside when ARCANGELO bid with five-sixteenths to go and was called upon in response, came in slightly at the quarter pole trading a small bump and brush with his main danger, yielded the front straightened away and steadily weakened to the finish. IL MIRACOLO just off the inside through the first turn, chased along the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the far turn under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, angled three to four wide into upper stretch and tired. RED ROUTE ONE four then three wide through the first turn, chased four then three wide down the backstretch and through the far turn under urging from

ARCANGELO saved ground just off the top pair into the first turn and lost some position into the backstretch tipping three paths off the inside, advanced mildly to regain what was lost seven furlongs from home settling back to be just off the pace once more, began another small advance five furlongs out and tucked inside with nine-sixteenths to go, was given a nudge midway on the turn and bid to be on near even terms with five-sixteenths remaining, traded a small bump and brush with NATIONAL TREASURE at the quarter pole before seizing command straightened away in the inside route into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, then began to drift out through the finish seven paths despite being flashed the crop to the right side along with an active left rein but held safe even though giving away ground to the end. FORTE just off the inside through the first turn, raced four wide in pursuit from mid pack down the backstretch, tipped out five wide through the far turn coming under coaxing and being flashed the crop to the right side when drifting slightly at the three-eighths pole, went seven wide at the top of the stretch and offered up a mild kick closing belatedly to just get up for the place honors in the final jumps. TAPIT TRICE away last without incident, came under coaxing and chased just off the inside through the first turn before tipping five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked four wide at the nine-sixteenths and commenced a bid on the front stacking outside a trio just off the leader at that station, angled five wide into upper stretch, dug in offering up a mild bid but was collared in the final strides for the place honors and forced to settle for the show. HIT SHOW four then three wide through the opening turn, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch just off the top pair, tucked three wide into the far turn coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths between rivals among a quartet just off the leader, got nudged by ANGEL OF EMPIRE to the two path at the three-eighths, tipped three wide at the head of the stretch and kept on to dead heat with his main rival at the finish. ANGEL OF EMPIRE coaxed from the start, raced five then four wide through the first turn before tipping six paths off the inside down the backstretch, briefly tucked five then four wide into the far turn, came in three wide three furlongs from home and nudged HIT SHOW to the two path when placed to coaxing at that station, swung four wide into upper stretch and kept on to dead heat at the end for the last major share. NATIONAL TREASURE forwardly placed from the start, raced three wide into the first turn latched on the early leader to the outside, took over command with a mile and three-sixteenths remaining and tipped to the four path down the backstretch settling in hand into a comfortable rhythm, tucked briefly three wide before taking to the two path into the far turn, came under challenge from a quartet half a mile from home and patiently fended them off awaiting greater challenge, got one to his inside when ARCANGELO bid with five-sixteenths to go and was called upon in response, came in slightly at the quarter pole trading a small bump and brush with his main danger, yielded the front straightened away and steadily weakened to the finish. IL MIRACOLO just off the inside through the first turn, chased along the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the far turn under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, angled three to four wide into upper stretch and tired. RED ROUTE ONE four then three wide through the first turn, chased four then three wide down the backstretch and through the far turn under curbing from the seven-sixteenths, cornered four wide at the top of the stretch and was bided home to the finish. TAPIT TRICE coaxed from the gate, established the front and showed the way briefly from the two path until headed for command with a mile and three-sixteenths to go, chased forwardly placed along the inside of NATIONAL TREASURE through to the nine-sixteenths, retreated thereafter and continued just off the inside into upper stretch, then got eased home to the wire.
