HOLY MISSION tracked the leaders down the backstretch from the middle of the pack, made a mild rail bid going into the turn but was empty and passed tired one in the stretch. GUTFIELD was hustled to the front to set the pace for a half and tired. YOU'RE MY ROCK raced near the back and was never a threat. CAN DANZER had an awkward start and trailed.
