THREE TECHNIQUE was bumped and forced out at the start, settled towards the rear, drafted in the two path on the turn, shifted three wide while asked at the quarter-pole, moved out from behind the leader inside the three-sixteenths, rallied to the front while still on his left lead inside the furlong marker, swapped to the proper lead while moving clear at the sixteenth-pole and powered off under steady handling. SYNTHESIS broke in then brushed with a foe, settled on the far outside, was roused five wide on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive, chased the winner into the final sixteenth, swapped back to his inside lead late and just got up for the place. CANDY MAN ROCKET broke out and bumped with an opponent, was well placed just off the pace while off the inside, ranged up in the three path on the turn, took over while set down into upper stretch, remained on his inside lead until just before the furlong marker then swapped to the proper lead, lost the advantage to the winner just inside that marker and proved no match then lost the place in the final stride while clear for the show. SHERIFF BIANCO brushed with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, chased in the four path on the turn, remained on his inside lead in upper stretch, swapped to the proper lead near the furlong marker and tired. LITTLE VIC brushed with a foe at the start, pressed the pace on the outside under a tight hold, went to the front inside the three-quarter pole, moved clear leaving the backstretch, traveled around the turn in the two path, was asked under pressure near the quarter-pole, lost the advantage into upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and gave way. TWISTED RIDE went to the front, showed the way under pressure to his outside, lost the advantage inside the three-quarter pole, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch and came up empty. WEYBURN broke a bit slow, settled at the rear of the field, was urged three wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
