6½ FURLONGS. (1.15) BC CUP DEBUTANTE S. Purse \$50,000 FOR TWO YEAR OLD FILLIES. The nomination payment of \$100 by midnight Saturday July 29, 2023 with \$750 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,500 will be accepted at the time of entry in addition to the races nomination, entry and start fees. 100% of all supplemental monies will be included in the \$50,000 guaranteed purse. \$50,000 guaranteed of which 55% goes to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 4% to fifth, and 2% to sixth through eighth. Preference will be based upon the rules outlined in the Hastings condition book at the time of entry. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$27,500 once allowed 3 lbs. Non-winners of \$12,000 once allowed 5 lbs. Non-winners of \$8,000 once allowed 7 lbs. Field limited to 11 starters. (Hazy. 8Q.)

LIZZIE'S RAYNE broke sharply and tracked the pacesetter into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, launched her bid two wide entering the final turn, assumed command leaving the turn, and drew clear late to prove best. WEEKENDINDELMAR was off a step slow, and found herself trailing the field into the first turn while saving ground at the rail, raced into a stalking trip from along the rail in the run down the backstretch, commenced her bid three wide entering the final turn, and closed determinedly two out from the rail in the drive to get up for the place. DONNA WYN away alertly and rushed to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, dictated the pace in the run down the backside, battled from the inside of LIZZIE'S RAYNE through the final turn, was unable to match strides with that rival leaving the turn, and was outfinished late for the place. BAKBURNER chased the leaders three wide entering the first turn, dropped back to trail entering the backstretch, began to lose touch with the field in the run to the final turn, and was eased over the final furlong.
