SMOKIN'T was reserved in the middle of the field on the inside, came under urging late on the backstretch, angled three then four wide on the far turn, bobbled near the five-sixteenths, rallied to make a bid between foes into upper stretch, fought between two rivals in the final furlong and gamely prevailed. DAKOTA GOLD was taken in hand between horses early, rounded the first turn in the two path, was reserved well off the pace, gained three wide early on the farturn then shifted five wide while closing fast, made an outside bid into upper stretch, fought outside of two foes in the final furlong and just missed while narrowly able to get the place. PORTFOLIO COMPANY dropped back along the rail early, fell well off the pace while saving ground, gained on the final turn, paused in traffic while closing fast late on that bend, found room between horses to make a bid into upper stretch, battled inside of the top two in the final furlong and just missed while clear for the show. SPEAK ING SCOUT hit the inside of the gate at the start then moved in early, saved ground while unhurried at the back, was roused on the final turn, spun three wide into the stretch, moved out outside the furlong marker and finished willingly for the last spot in the superfecta. DOCTOR DAVIS showed early speed on the inside of a foe under urging then was taken in hand while beaten to the front, raced in the three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, ranged up in the three path on the far turn, made a brief bid into upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and weakened. TIZ THE BOMB moved in at the rear, traveled three wide going around the first turn, settled at the back, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. OCEAN ATLANTIQUE was hustled from the gate, went around the first turn in the two path, was reserved on the outside, came under urging in a good striking position on the far turn, dropped to the rail coming to the quarter-pole and capitulated. MID DAY IMAGE hit the outside of the gate at the start, moved in while asked for speed, showed the way in the two path, dropped to the rail at the guarter-pole then was swallowed up into upper stretch and tired.
