1¹/₆ MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.39) WITH ANTICIPATION S. Grade III Purse \$175,000 INNER TURF FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. Non-Lasix race pursuant to 4043.2(7)(e)(5) Lasix not permitted within 48 hours of post time. By subscription of \$175 each which should accompany the nomination; \$875 to pass the entry box and an additional \$875 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$875 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race on the turf other than claiming allowed 2 lbs.; maidens allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. GALA BRAND just off the inside through the first turn unhurried and settling at the tail of the field, raced two to three wide in pursuit patiently handled until put to coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled out to swing eight wide at the top of the stretch, offered up a good kick to close outside rivals tussling head to head with the runner up before taking sole command seventy yards from home, then gamely edged away to the finish to prevail. CARSON'S RUN just off the inside through the first turn just off the pace, tracked three wide down the backstretch before tucking back to the two path through the far turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled out seven wide into upper stretch, rallied between foes taking narrow command just inside the eighth pole, dug in head to head with the aforementioned foe and was headed seventy yards from home, fought on gamely inside to secure the place honors. SPIRIT PRINCE forwardly placed along the inside into the first turn, settled tracking just off the inside from mid pack, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole and swung five wide into upper stretch, rallied back into prominence a furlong out, ran on willingly to clearly procure the show honors while unable to match the top pair in the late stages. GET SPOOLED three wide through the first turn, raced two to three wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command nearing the eighth pole, got overwhelmed and overhauled just inside that station and weakened in the late stages. NOMOS three then two wide through the first turn, chased three to four wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, cornered six wide into upper stretch and came up empty in the final furlong. WINE COLLECTOR tracked the pace along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. MARKET STREET established the front and showed the way in hand just off the inside through sensible splits, came under coaxing and angled inside near the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and yielded outside the eighth pole, then weakened through to the finish.
