BERCASA (IRE) was rated early on the inside, jumped poorly over number four, then was shuffled back to last on the second circuit, then closed well on the outside to get up under a drive. RIGHT TEMPO (FR) was rated along, then closed well up the inside but was out-kicked by the winner, got place award. CAINU DOTHE TWIST tracked the pace throughout, made a bid on the turn to vie for command, between rivals by the quarter pole, then kept on to the wire but was outfinished. BELLA COOLA set the pace and then vied for command, then shook clear again, then vied for the lead on the turn and then gained a short lead nearing the far long marker and gave way grudgingly to the wire. MET IN MIAMI was settled early, then offered a belated rally but needed more. NEW APPOINTMENT (IRE) was reserved early, made an outside move on the far turn to loom boldly but came up empty in the lane. BOURBON DIVERSION prompted the pace and then vied for the lead and tired.
