By subscription of \$100 to accompany the nomination by Midnight Saturday, September 2, 2023 with an additional \$750 to enter and \$1,000 to start. \$50,000 guaranteed of which 55% goes to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 4% to fifth, and 2% to sixth through eighth, finishers ninth through twelfth will receive their starter fee back. High weights preferred. Total earnings as recorded by Equibase in 2022-2023 will be used in determining preference of horses assigned equal weights. Starters to be named through the entry box by closing time of entries. Field limited to 12 starters.

INFINITE PATIENCE away alertly and raced to the lead three wide entering the first turn, and raced on an uncontested lead through the stretch the first time, turned back a bid by WANDALITA in the run to the final turn, opened a clear advantage through the turn, and was never seriously threatened late under confident handling. WE B THREE broke sharply and tracked the pacesetter into the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, maintained a tracking trip from along the rail in the run down the backstretch, rallied smartly from along the rail entering the final turn, shifted off the rail for the drive, and closed willingly two wide in the drive but was unable to seriously threaten the winner late. WANDALITA away well, and stalked the leader through the stretch the first time while racing two out from the rail, forced the issue two out from the rail in the run to the final turn, was unable to match strides with that rival entering the turn, and finished from along the rail in the drive to hold on for a share. NO PEOPLE settled off the early pace while trailing the field through the stretch the first time, bided her time at the back of the pack in the run down the backstretch, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but failed to make a late impact.
