FIL M STAR raced in the three path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked in the three path on the farturn, took the lead coming to the quarter-pole, led under a drive into the final furlong then was overtaken by the winner and proved no match while just able to get the place. LAW PROFESSOR tossed his head while lugging out from the two path to the four path early on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the four path on the far turn, pursued the leader under a drive into the final furlong and just missed the place. CHARGE IT was hust led from the gate, moved from the rail to the two path on the first turn, was well placed down the backstretch, passed the half-mile pole under urging, chased in the two path on the far turn, had the rider lose his crop outside the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. O'CONNOR (CHI) was restless in the gate, broke a bit slow, angled in at the rear, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, moved from the rail to the three path on the far turn and gained ground but failed to threaten. TYSON was carried from the four path to the six path early on the first turn then bumped with a rival, settled on the far outside, was urged five wide on the far turn, spun six wide into the stretch, remained on his inside lead in the drive and came upempty. COSTA TERRA dropped from the two path to the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while saving ground on the far turn and failed to threaten. PIPELINE went to the front, traveled around the opening bendin the two path, showed the way down the backstretch, was asked while inside on the far turn, lost the lead at the quarter-pole and gave way.
