WAR AT SEA settled just off of the early pace, raced two then three wide through the backstretch run and tracked the moderate pace to the half-mile marker, chased the leaders two wide to the quarter pole, was steered to the four path into upper stretch then shifted six wide approaching the furlong marker, responded to urging and rallied into the final sixteenth, closed fast in deep stretch and was up in the final strides to nail SILENT POET for the win. SILENT POET broke alertly and assumed command away from the start, cleared to the rail into the first turn and set a pressured pace into the backstretch run, was well rated while carving out moderate fractions approaching the half-mile pole, continued to be pressured by I'MGON NABESOMEBODY into the far turn, shook freeinto the stretch and was set down at the furlong pole, dug in and held foes at bay into the final sixteenth, was all out in the final strides and was nailed on the wire for the win, while besting the rest, TRIPOLI was away in good order, took back off of the early pace and saved ground into the first turn, was well placed while along the rail through the backstretch run, lost a bit of ground while chasing along the far turn, re-rallied into the stretch and vied for the lead at the furlong marker, battled into the final sixteenth, was outkicked in deep stretch and held for third at the finish. LAMMAS (GB) was unhurried in the early running, raced two wide into the backstretch run and made a mild advance at the half-mile pole, was steered outside of runners and loomed four wide approaching the quarter marker, swung five wide into the stretch, battled to the furlong grounds, could not find the needed response in deep stretch and was outfinished. IL BELLATOR tracked the early pace from the outside, maintained that outside path into the backstretchrun and was well placed heading to the half-mile marker, mounted a three wide bid along the far turn, swung to the four path into upper stretch and lost position approaching the furlong marker, could not keep pace into deep stretch and weakened. I'M GONNABESO MEBODY was hustled leaving the start and was prominent into the first turn, prompted the moderate pace into the backstretch run and kept close attendance to SIL ENT POET heading to the half-mile marker, came under pressure while two wide and between runners at the quarter marker, lost position into the stretch and chased to the furlong grounds, lacked a late response and gave way. SUPERMAZEL was allowed to settle in the early stages, saved ground into the backstretch run while not far back, came in a bit tight at the half-mile marker and was shuffled back heading into the far turn, lost contact approaching the quarter pole and tired in the stretch.
