SHARP LORENZO, taken snugly in hand and well off the pace into the backstretch, was angled out near the five eighths then commenced a run leaving the half, rolled up five wide to engage rivals from the outside approaching the quarter pole, emerged in a battle with PLEASEUSETHEPORTAL leaving the three sixteenths, gained the advantage dueling past the furlong grounds, responded to left handed asks and edged away nearing the wire. PLEASEUSETHEPORTAL, five wide leaving theseven eighths, rated off the embattled leaders, moved up menacingly into the far turn, bid four deep and took a slim lead nearing the quarter pole, was joined from his outside soon after, sparred with the winner to deep stretch then gaveway grudgingly. WELL IMAGINE THAT angled off heels into the first turn then moved up to stalk off the rail, edged up and bid three deep leaving the far turn, held a short lead between runners past the five sixteenths, failed to quicken with the top pair in upper stretch, shifted out and churned on to gain the show. LITE RANCHIN KID sped to the front then dropped in when clearing into the first turn, was joined past the seven eighths then headed, dueled along towards the rail from the five eighths to the five sixteenths, came out a path nearing the lane and weakened. GENERAL CROOK, brushed and steadied soon after the break, was forced out six wide by FERRARI RED entering the first turn, regrouped and gained off the inside into the far turn, shifted in towards the rail to pursue past the five sixteenths then weakened. SHINING TIGER brushed with a foe soon after the start, raced four wide into the first, dropped in a couple of paths and moved to a short lead outside LITE RANCHIN KID was re engaged by that one mid way through the backstretch, dueled between runners leaving the three eighths, steadied when not quite quickening with the leaders near the quarter pole and gave way. R BARRACUDA, towards the inside, was not a factor. FERRARI RED steadied off heels soon after the break then got out multiple paths entering the first turn, checked repeatedly when difficult to settle through the opening half mile then dropped back.
