AMIDST WAVES moved in while well spotted just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, took an awkward step near the three-eighths pole and paused was roused once straightened for the drive, rallied to make a bid outside the furlong marker, dueled with a rival into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to get the show. INDEPENDENCEAVENUE pressed the pace on the outside then in the two path on the turn, took the lead in upper stretch, dueled with a foe into the final sixteenth and was out-kicked then just missed the show. KODIAC WINTERGREEN (IRE) made light contact with a foeat the start, was urged along off the pace, went two to three wide on the turn, spun four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick.
