1 MILE. (Turf) (1.31) WILD APPLAUSE S. Purse \$150,000 FOR FILLIEST THREE YEARS OLD. Non-Lasix Race pursuant to 4043.2 (7)(e)(5) Lasix not permitted within 48 hours of post time. By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$750 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded sweepstake allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake lifetime or a race other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowance in 2023 allowed 4 lbs. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 10, 2023 with 35 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the Main Track.) (Rail at 18 feet).

LIGURIA charged the front of the gate just before the latch was sprung and came away clearly in front, dropped back then settled off the pace, fell to the rear while patiently handled on the turn, was roused while swinging seven wide into upper stretch, rallied outside to make a bid inside the furlong marker, took the lead into the final sixteenth and proved best under good handling. TAX IMPLICATIONS (GB) settled at the rear, was roused three wide on the turn, rallied six wide into the stretch, closed strongly to get the lead outside the furlong marker, led to the sixteenth-pole then was headed by the winner and missed while clear for the place. SOVIET EXCESS brushed with a rival at the start, tracked the pace on the outside while in hand, was given her cue in the three path on the turn, gained four wide into the stretch, took the lead near the three-sixteenths, lost the advantage to the runner-up outside the furlong marker and weakened but just held the show. CECILE brushed with a foe leaving the gate, was hard held while rank between foes onto the backstretch, raced under tight restraint towards the back, traveled three wide on the turn, gained five wide into the stretch, made a bid between foes outside the furlong marker but also weakened then just missed the show. BREATH AWAY (GB) bumped solidly with an opponent at the start, was rank under steady restraint onto and early on the backstretch then reserved off the pace, drafted in the two path on the turn, waited briefly coming to the quarter-pole then was asked three wide into the stretch, raced behind foes under a solid hand-ride to the furlong marker then angled out and lacked the needed response. IM JUST KIDDIN was taken under a tight hold early, became very rank under steady restraint onto and early on the backstretch, tracked the pace under a tight hold, was let out in the two path on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and tired. VIOLET GIBSON (IRE) settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was asked late on that bend, chased behind horses in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and capitulated. KERRY bumped solidly with a rival at the start, moved up in hand to take the lead then went clear, vied inside on the turn, lost the advantage in upper stretch and gave way.
