1 MILE 70 YARDS. (1401) MINNESOTA DERBY Purse \$100,000 (plus\$10,000 MBF – Minnesota Breeders Fund) **FOR COLTS AND GELDINGS, THREE YEARS OLD WHICH ARE REGISTERED MINNESOTA BREDS.** \$250 to nominate by Saturday, April 1. Late nomination fee: \$750 by Thursday, June 1. \$500 to enter, \$500 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$2,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$100,000 Guaranteed (Plus \$10,000 from the Minnesota Breeders Fund for horses Sired & Foaled in Minnesota) of which \$60,000 to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in the Condition Book. Weight: 122 lbs. Maidens allowed 5 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Minnesota Derby will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. High weights on the scale will be preferred (winners preferred). Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Failure to draw into the race will result in a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The final purse will be reduced by the cost of any Out of Competition testing required by the Minnesota Racing Commission as a condition of competing in this race. Nominations closed Saturday, April 1 with 35.

ROSES BY LIAM awaited options through the opening half by trekking the two path and looming just off the pace, swung to three wide at upper stretch, then finished with best stride of all in final furlong to kick clear in the end. JOSE PATIO flashed early speed and led the field through opening half, was on even terms near the quarter pole, then failed to fend off rivals in closing stages. IT'S BOBS BUSINESS pressed the early pace three wide, angled to four wide and was close up at upper stretch, but was outfinished in final strides. WIN OVER WYATT lacked a serious bid after settling into mid pack and travelling an inside route. SIR STERLING hurried from outset and loomed two wide around the opening turn, forced the pace along the backstretch, was on even terms near the quarter pole, led the field briefly at upper stretch, then rapidly faded in final furlong. RAMBLING GAMBLER MAN passed tiring foes in late going after being unhurried from outset. REJECTION HURTS lacked a serious bid after showing reserve through the opening half. WEST ISLAND settled into the second flight through opening turn, lost ground to frontrunners along the backstretch, and tired in latter portion of contest.
