5½ FURLONGS. (Turf) (1.001) TROY S. Grade III. Purse \$300,000 FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Non-Lasix race pursuant to 4043.2 (7)(e)(5) Lasix not permitted within 48 hours of post time. By subscription of \$300 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,500 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$110,000 in 2022-23 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake in 2023 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-bred allowance in 2023 allowed 6 lbs. Trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 22, 2023 with 16 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the Main Track). (Rail at 18 feet).

COGBURN got bumped at the start by IKIGAI and in turn bumped CARAVEL, chased along the inside from mid pack, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge through the final furlong, bobbed just outside the sixteenth pole and then again just inside the sixteenth marker when attempting to collar the leader, seized command seventy yards from the finish, dug in to prevail at the end. NOBALS coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside under pressure from REMUDA to the outside, tucked inside through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole and took the inside route into upper stretch, edged away under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under growing late threat and was caught with seventy yards to the finish and forced to settle for the place honors. THIN WHITE DUKE broke out a step at the start getting away and then grew briefly detached at the tail of the field when devoid of speed, chased just off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under coaxing from the three-eighths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to procure the show honors. CARAVEL got bumped at the start by COGBURN due to pressure from IKIGAI, came under coaxing and led briefly before being headed by NOBALS shortly after, chased along the inside down the backstretch, tipped briefly to the two path at the seven-sixteenths before heading three wide at the three-eighths, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, angled five wide into upper stretch and floated out two to three additional paths straightened away, then stayed on one paced through to the finish. REMUDA pressed the pace of NOBALS from the outside three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then from the two path through the turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home, weakened in the late stages, then was reported to have bled. MISTER MMMMM coaxed from the start, chased two to three wide down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn and into upper stretch and tired. IKIGAI broke out a step at the start bumping COGBURN into CARAVEL, chased just off the inside under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, continued just off the inside for home and tired.
