B. f. (Feb), by Justify - Instant Reflex, by Quality Road. Trainer Brown Chad C. Bred by Yeguada Centurion SL (Ky).

HARD TO JUSTIFY forwardly placed early then applied pressure from outside up the backstretch, pushed on with a quarter mile left to run, fought between into the in final furlong, gained the advantage in midstretch and held off rivals from both sides to the wire. PORTA FORTUNA (IRE) stalked in between rivals in the two path through both turns, launched at the eighth pole, finished gamely between then along the inside but could not get by the winner. SHE FEELS PRETTY rated four deep in the early going, remained wide into the far turn, took aim threewide into the lane, bid five deep at the eighth pole, fought three deep in the final sixteenth and got edged for second. CONTENT (IRE) became rank early then steadied on the first turn while on the inside, stayed along the fence then tipped two wide on the far turn, moved out further in the drive, surged in deep stretch but was too late. AUSTERE stalked the speed along the inside early, coaxed along into the lane, put in a rail bid in upper stretch but got outkicked in the late stages. BUCHU pulled early on the inside and ran up on heels on the first turn, traveled in mid-pack up the backstretch, saved ground to the stretch and kept on through the final furlong while needing to find more. CARLA'S WAY (IRE) was forced to check off heels early, pulled three deep on the first turn and backstretch, roused three then four wide on the far turn, drifted out in the lane and could not threaten. LIFE'S AN AUDIBLE raced up close three deep, remained in the three path to the stretch and weakened. DREAMFYRE had good early speed to clear the field and crossed over to the inside, pressured from outside on the backstretch, held the advantage into the lane, clung to a narrow lead at the eighth pole, relinquished the lead midstretch and weakened late. LAULNE (FR) steadied off heels early, chased between in the two path off the pace and failed to respond when called upon. LES PAVOTS (IRE) broke a step slow, raced outside a rival at the back early on, went three deep into the far turn, four wide into the stretch, moved out and failed to menace. FLATTERY settled inside early, got shuffled back on the first turn, saved ground to the stretch and was not a factor. GALA BRAND unhurried three deep early, went two then three wide on the far turn and failed to make an impact. BUTTERCREAM BABE broke a bit slow, pulled early then between rivals, spun three wide into the lane and came up empty.

HARD TO JUSTIFY forwardly placed early then applied pressure from outside up the backstretch, pushed on with a quarter mile left to run, fought between into the in final furlong, gained the advantage in midstretch and held off rivals from both sides to the wire. PORTA FORTUNA (IRE) stalked in between rivals in the two path through both turns, launched at the eighth pole, finished gamely between then along the inside but could not get by the winner. SHE FEELS PRETTY rated four deep in the early going, remained wide into the far turn, took aim three wide into the lane, bid five deep at the eighth pole, fought three deep in the final sixteenth and got edged for second. CONTENT (IRE) became rank early then steadied on the first turn while on the inside, stayed along the fence then tipped two wide on the far turn, moved out further in the drive, surged in deep stretch but was too late. AUSTERE stalked the speed along the inside early, coaxed along into the lane, put in a rail bid in upper stretch but got outkicked in the late stages. BUCHU pulled early on the inside and ran up on heels on the first turn, traveled in mid-pack up the backstretch, saved ground to the stretch and kept on through the final furlong while needing to find more. CARLA'S WAY (IRE) was forced to check off heels early, pulled three deep on the first turn and backstretch, roused three then four wide on the far turn, drifted out in the lane and could not threaten. LIFE'S AN AUDIBLE raced up close three deep, remained in the three path to the stretch and weakened. BUTTERCREAM BABE broke a bit slow, pulled early then between rivals, spun three wide into the lane and came up empty.
