Free nomination by Sunday, March 17. \$2,500 to enter. \$250,000 Guaranteed. A supplemental nomination fee of \$200 may be made prior to closing time of entries. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. *(FTBOA offers up to \$50,000 to the owners of Registered Florida-breds, divided \$30,000 to the winner, \$15,000 to second, \$5,000 to third plus \$50,000 for eligible FSS owners divided \$30,000 to the winner, \$15,000 to second, \$5,000 to third). Weight: 122 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners, graded stakes-placed, non-restricted stakes winners, stakes placed then by highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner.

POWER SQUEEZE bumped with an outer foe early into the first turn, laid in midpack inside of foes, tipped out to the five path under a drive midway around the far turn, swung from six path into the stretch, got herded out thru the final sixteenth, but rallied past an inner foe in the closing stages. WAYS AND MEANS bumped with an inner foe and steadied early into the first turn, was held up in the six path turning into the backstretch, moved up outside of contenders midway down the backstretch, bid three wide around the far turn, took the lead and was coaxed from the four path entering the stretch, but drifted out in the final sixteenth, and was caught by an outer foe late to place. INTO CHAMPAGNE showed the way in the two path, came under a ride midway around the far turn, but lost the lead at the top of the stretch, and evened out for show. GUN SONG broke out and bumped an outer foe, laid up close in the three path, bid between foes rounding the far turn, floated out to the five path at the top of the lane, but faded. SCALABLE chased in the five path, floated out to the six path midway around the far turn, and did not factor. DO GOODER got in tight and bumped with horses on both sides early into the first turn, raced off the pace in the four path but failed to menace in the three path down the lane. AMERICA'S VOW got bumped by an inner foe at the start, was unhurried in the five path early into the backstretch, roused from the two path into the far turn, but came up empty entering the stretch. FIONA'S MAGIC prompted the pace in the four path but backed up around the far turn. NEOM CITY trailed out in the seven path down the backstretch, was piled up turning into the stretch, and walked off.
