WHERE'S MYRING was hustled from the gate, saved ground while taken in hand on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace down the backstretch, drafted inside early on the far turn, shifted three wide while roused later on that bend, rallied outside to get the lead in upper stretch, shook clear into the final furlong and drew away under strong urging. REGULATORY RISK raced in the three path for most of the first turn then dropped to the two path, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid in the two to three path on the far turn, took a short lead near the quarter-pole, lost the advantage to the winner in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and proved no match while well clear for the place. GIN GIN rounded the first turn in the two path, was well spotted just off the pace, came under urging late on the backstretch, chased in the three path on the far turn, was driven four wide into the stretch and tired while able to get the show. WHOCOULDAASKFORMO bumped with a rival at the start, went two to three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, saved ground while roused on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the two path and failed to threaten while completing the superfecta. LIFE TALK bumped with a foe after the start, went three to four wide on the first turn, was taken up off heels briefly near the eleven-sixteenths, settled on the outside, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, spun three wide into the stretch, raced between foes passing the three-sixteenths pole and came up empty. BARBRATINA bumped with a foe after the start then was taken up in tight quarters, went around the first turn in the two path, settled near the back, angled to the five path from the two path outside the three-eighths pole, moved closer around that final turn but failed to respond. CARMELINA broke out but came out in front then moved in early, rounded most of the first turn in the two path then dropped to the rail, showed the way down the backstretch, vied inside to the two path on the far turn, was asked inside the three-eighths pole, lost the advantage near the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and tired. PRINCESS VINO bumped with an opponent at the start, saved ground while dropping well behind the rest of the field and showed little. MUNNY GRAB broke out at the start, went four then threewide on the first turn, raced just off the pace on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, dropped back four then three wide on the final turn and retreated.
