GOOD LORD LORRIE br ushed with a foe at the start, was taken in hand early,rounded the first turn in the tw o path, was well spotted behind the leading duo, moved closer late on the backstretch, was asked while inside on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, rallie d outside to make a bid near thefurlong marker and got up under strong ur ging. THE BIG TORPEDO trav eled around the first turn in the two path, settled on the outside, moved closer late on thebackstretch, rallied thr ee wide on the far turn, made a bid at thefive-sixteenths pole, took ov er into upper stretch, led under a drive into thefinal sixteenth but was caught while able to get the place. WALLEY WORLD saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was roused three wide on thefar turn, chased the top two in the stretch and willingly earned the show. CARSON'S RUN settled on the inside, steadied outside the five-sixt eenths whileheld up on the far turn, moved to the two path late on that bend, steadied off heels approaching the quarterpole then swerve dout badly, ca me seven wide into the str etch and lacked the needed response. ELYSIAN MEADOWS went around theopening bend in the tw o path, settled at the rear, went two then thr ee wide on the far turn, was for ced out badly approac hing the the quarter-pole, came eightwide int o the stretch and failed to threaten. W ORKS FOR ME brushed witha foe atthe start, dueled outside of a rival while in the two path for the opening threefurlongs, moved clear outside the half-mile pole, was chall enged while inside on the far turn, lost the advantage into upper stretch and weakened. RIDGEWOOD RUNNER dueled on the inside of a rival for the opening three furlongs then dropped off the pace, switched out outside the half-mile pole, was urged in the two path on the final turn and faltered then was eased but walked off. FOLLOWINGA STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE RACE, CARSON'S RUN WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FOURTH AND PLACED FIFTH FOR INTERFERENCE NEAR THE QUARTER-POLE. QUARTERMILEFRACTION WASOMITTED DUE TO SOMETHING TRIPPING THE SENSOR EARLY
