

1 MILE. (Turf) (1.33²) 20TH RUNNING OF THE APPALACHIAN. Grade III. Purse \$125,000 FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$6,250 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$625 to enter and an additional \$625 to start, with \$125,000 guaranteed, of which \$77,500 to the owner of the winner, \$25,000 to second, \$12,500 to third, \$6,250 to fourth and \$3,750 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over on the turf since October 6, 4 lbs.; two races at a mile or over other than claiming, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Appalachian will be limited to twelve if on the Haggin or ten with two also eligibles if on the Keeneland Course. In the event that more than twelve fillies pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 9, 2008 with 26 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track. (Rail at 15 feet).

ALWAJEEHA within striking distance three wide while unhurried, made a quick four wide move on the second turn when asked, reached a challenging position entering the stretch, gained a short lead with a furlong to go then had to be fully extended to prevail. SWEEPSTAKE (IRE) steadied early when I LOST MY CHOO drifted out entering the first turn, was reserved while close up, saved ground behind the leaders on the second turn, had to wait in midstretch when blocked, angled out with a furlong to go and finished well but missed. I LOST MY CHOO drifted out entering the first turn when a bit rank behind the leader, tracked the pace in hand, challenged on when ready on the second turn and held on tenaciously in the drive but missed. VANCY PANTS outrun for a half, came four wide out of the second turn and closed willingly late. NAMASTE'S WISH fanned five wide when reserved into the first turn, made a good three wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. MUCH OBLIGED forwardly placed along the inside, weakened in the drive. ABSOLUTELY CINDY steadied early behind the runner up when in traffic entering the first turn, recovered to race within striking distance off the inside but had nothing left late. LICKETY LEMON could not menace. MRS PETOSKI sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace to the stretch and tired. FASHION ROCKS (IRE) four wide into the first turn when moving to within striking distance, stayed well to the final quarter and gave way.
