5 FURLONGS. (Turf) (.552) 14TH RUNNING OF THE AEGON TURF SPRINT. Grade III. Purse \$100,000 FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three year olds 118 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 twice on the turf since October 5 allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 on the turf in 2008, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner given by Aegon. (If this race is taken off of the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Wednesday, April 9, 2008 with 34 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs).

MR. NIGHTLINGER bobbed a bit at the start, recovered quickly, set the pace off the inside, repulsed a bid by **INDIAN ASHTON** on the turn, edged off a bit for the drive and held sway late. **SALUTE THE COUNT** close up along the inside, dropped back a bit on the turn then lodged a mild bid for the place. **ATTICUS KRISTY** in hand early, saved ground on the turn, angled out for the drive and made a good late gain. **INDIAN ASHTON** bobbed while breaking slowly, hit the side of the starting gate stall, rushed up four wide into the turn, challenged late on the turn but tired late. **THE NTH DEGREE** close up three wide, weakened. **SGT. BERT** within striking distance off the rail, tired. **DEMARCATIION** was outrun along the inside. **FUNKY PIRATE** within striking distance off the rail, faded.
