HEROS REWARD, five wide early, was angled down to the two path entering the turn, advanced four wide into the lane, lodged a bid between rivals in mid stretch, dueled past the sixteenth marker, gained command late and proved best under a steady drive. TRUE TO TRADITION was steadied off the heels of the winner nearing the turn, drifted out briefly early turn, angled out five wide nearing the quarter pole, forged to command in mid stretch, dueled on a slim lead, drifted in late and was outfinished. BLUE SAILOR saved ground in a forward position, was checked sharply entering the turn, recovered and advanced inside mid turn, angled out entering the lane and finished with good energy. MR MUTTER settled towards the inside, swung out past the eighth pole and closed willingly. HESA BIG STAR had speed from the gate, chased three wide around the turn, lodged a bid between rivals in upper stretch, vied past the eighth pole then faded in the final sixteenth. BEER STIEN lost ground four wide and failed to respond. ROUSE THE CAT, pinched back at the break, was hustled up inside soon after, angled out in the drive and had some belated action. I'VE GOT SPEED lacked speed, saved ground into the lane, swung out and failed to threaten. TOMMIE'S STAR rushed three wide to clear nearing the turn, set the pace two wide, was collared in upper stretch, held well to the eighth pole then surrendered. NACASCOLOR prompted the pace while saving ground and gave way in mid stretch. S K R'S SPARTAN, forced in some at the break, raced three wide around the turn and failed to menace. Objections by the riders of BLUE SAILOR and TRUE TO TRADITION against the winner for alleged interference nearing the turn were not allowed.
