ZAFTIG stumbled at the start, quickly recovered and was taken outside early on the backstretch, rated kindly within striking distance of the pacesetter, advanced on her own courage to commence her challenge approaching the top of the stretch, responded positively when given her cue, drawing on even terms with that foe at the furlong marker, then drew off with authority, despite having had the rider lose the whip in midstretch. INDIAN BLESSING set a lively pace under a firm hold, proved no match when the winner drew alongside midstretch but continued on to the wire with good courage to be clearly second best. GAME FACE forwardly placed three wide was through after going three quarters. GOLDEN DOC A stumbled at the start and was outrun.
