1 MILE. (Turf) (1.31<sup>3</sup>) 24TH RUNNING OF THE POKER HANDICAP. Grade III. Purse \$100,000 A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination; A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 may be made by Sunday, July 6; \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added. All entrants will be required to pay entry and starting fees. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Dirt weights: Three year olds 119. Older 123. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes on the dirt in 2008 allowed 3 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 5 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, June 28, 2008 with 33 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.). (Rail at 9 feet).

TAM LIN (GB) raced three wide and finished willingly. OPERATION RED DAWN saved ground until the stretch, was up for the show. SENSATIONAL HUMOR forwardly placed until the eighth pole along the rail, tired. STEPPENWOLFER devoid of early foot, was fanned three wide turning for home, failed to make an impact.
