NEIL THE KNIFE hit the gate at the break, was off the rail and in touch on the turn then came home from there with a mild bid to nail the show. ANOTHER ASCOT in touch and saving ground on the turn, was outfinished in the drive. ZARROC was off the pace and not a factor while bidding off the rail. CHEMISTRY CLASS had an inside trip and no serious bid.
