DRY MARTINI outrun for six furlongs, was fanned four wide into lane, rallied in earnest when asked for a response after being straightened away in upper stretch, left the furlong grounds with a clear advantage then drew away the final furlong while being hand urged to the finish line. STUD MUFFIN unhurried until reaching the far turn, unleashed a four wide sweep, circling rivals to reach a contending position turning for home, failed to keep pace with the top one during the final furlong but continued on with good courage to be second best. TEMPORARY SAINT broke sharply, worked his way to the front during the run to the opening bend, showed the way while kept off the inside until upper stretch, tired during the stretch drive. RAVEL forwardly placed three wide, lacked a rally. BRILLIANT SON faded off a ground-saving journey. SOLAR FLARE (ARG) tracked the pacesetter while travelling in the two path for six furlongs before folding.
