SHADOWLESS raced midpack between rivals, closed late backstretch, gained contention late turn, bid a furlong out and took a short lead then held under a drive. ROUSE THE CAT vied early then was taken in hand when headed late backstretch, pressed the pacesetter to the top of the stretch, rebid inside and took a clear lead, was headed a furlong out and chased to the wire. STORM TREASURE raced off the pace, closed three-wide late turn, came four-wide into the stretch, launched a strong stretch drive and was gaining late. FIELD COMMISSION, well back early, angled out closing late turn, came seven-wide into the stretch and rallied gamely. LEGAL MOVE raced midpack between rivals, angled out while closing late turn, came seven-wide into the stretch but lacked the necessary response. HOSTA RICA showed brief speed with his front-running rivals, settled quickly and dropped off the pace, saved ground, was hustled late turn but evened out in the final sixteenth. JUST RUSHING raced midpack four-wide, was hustled through the turn, came six-wide into the stretch, launched an all out drive but evened out late. THE GREAT CARUSO had brief speed but was taken back midway through the backstretch, stalked the pace, loomed up four-wide at the top of the stretch but tired. STORM CALLER settled well off the early pace, was hustled on the turn, came six-wide into the stretch but never reached contention. MAIN EXECUTIVE dueled early, shook clear into the turn, set a pressured pace, was engaged at the top of the stretch and tired.
