QUALITY ROAD jostled between rivals at the start, chased THIS ONES FOR PHIL three wide around the turn, moved to gain command from that rival in early stretch, then drew away under steady urging. THEREGOESJOJO reserved along the inside after breaking a step slowly, swung out for the stretch run and closed to prove second best while unable stay with the winner. BEEHOVEN outrun early, raced three wide around the turn, swung widest of all for the stretch run and passed tired rivals for the show. CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN bumped with TAQARUB at the start, chased the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, angled out and tired in the drive. THIS ONES FOR PHIL bumped with QUALITY ROAD at the start, quickly moved to the fore, made the pace off the rail into the stretch, then gave way. BEE CEE CEE off slowly, was outrun. NOTONTHEPAGE rated in striking position racing off the rail, faltered leaving the turn. JACK SPRATT was not a factor. TAQARUB jostled between rivals at the start, chased the leaders off the rail around the turn, then faded. BREAK WATER EDISON broke awkwardly, chased the leaders three wide into the turn, stopped and was eased in the final eighth.
