

1 1/8 MILES. (1.47<sup>3</sup>) 30TH RUNNING OF THE MAMP. Grade II. Purse \$150,000 FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each by Saturday, March 14, 2009, which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$1,500 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$90,000; \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made on Thursday, March 26, 2009, at a fee of \$6,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 122 lbs. SEA CHANTER stalked the winner three wide to nearing the stretch, then was no match for that rival while continuing on with good courage for the place. GINGER BREW unhurried early, circled rivals four wide to reach contention on the far turn, then tired. STRIKING TOMISUE rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and faltered. HAMSAL stalked the pace into the far turn and faded. AFRICAN VIOLET was outrun. SO GLITZY was through after six furlongs.
