TURFISTE set the pace early while on the inside into the turn then drew clear in the stretch under a steady drive. KING PUMA chased the pace early, angled into the four path inside the quarter pole and was gaining on the winner late but to no avail. HE AIN'T RIGHT was settled off the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn with some gain in the stretch run. PHOSPHORESCENT was unhurried early, angled into the four path entering the lane and had a mild gain in the stretch drive. SHANES GOLD was well placed early, angled into the five path inside the quarter pole with no late bid in the stretch. RUDY FLYER angled into the three path in the turn while no threat late. MUSIC CITY tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and soon retreated. KENTUCKYSOLDIERBOY was never involved.
