By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box; \$1,000 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$100,000; or \$50,000 twice allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 other than restricted stake; or \$35,000 in 2009, 5 lbs.; \$30,000; or three races other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 21, 2009 with 29 Nominations.

CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN raced under a firm hold between horses in the early stages, moved up from outside while well in hand at the half mile pole, gradually gained while three wide leaving the turn, charged to the front opening a clear advantage a furlong out and drew off under steady right hand encouragement. TAQARUB was well placed while pressing the pace in the two path on the backstretch, made a run to challenge midway on the turn, gained a slim advantage in upper stretch, relinquished the lead to the winner in midstretch and continued on willingly to best the others. YANO sprinted clear along the inside, set the pace under pressure to the top of the stretch, battled into midstretch and weakened in the final eighth. HATFIELD raced in good position along the rail for five furlongs and lacked a strong closing response. NOT FOR SILVER raced up close in the two path, angled in while just behind the leaders on the turn, saved ground into upper stretch and finished evenly. ROCKETING RETURNS was unhurried between horses, raced in traffic on the far turn, swung four wide while gaining slightly on the turn and flattened out. KING PUMA raced in midpack between horses while three wide for five furlongs and lacked a further response. LYIN' HEART trailed to the turn, drifted six wide and failed to menace. COUNTER MOVE checked slightly after the start, was never a factor.
