The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 in 2009 other than restricted stake allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000; or three races other than maiden or claiming, 5 lbs.; \$35,000; or two races other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 11, 2009 with 31 Nominations.

MR. FANTASY steadied briefly after being bothered at the start, was carried out briefly in the early stages, moved quickly to the rail, settled in good position while saving ground, rallied along the fence to gain a clear advantage at the quarter pole, extended his lead in midstretch then held off THIS ONES FOR PHIL under a vigorous hand ride. THIS ONES FOR PHIL dropped back in the early stages, trailed along the inside for a half, moved out on the far turn, steadied while lacking room behind a wall of horses on the turn, moved back to the rail for clear sailing entering the stretch and closed steadily outside the winner to clearly best the others. GONE ASTRAY was well placed along the inside for a half mile, gained slightly off the rail on the turn, moved between horses to threaten at the quarter pole but couldn't sustain his bid. JUST A COINCIDENCE raced just off the early pace from outside, lodged a mild four wide move at the quarter pole and gradually tired thereafter. SUPREME SUMMIT stumbled at the start, drifted nine wide along the backstretch, moved inward at the half mile pole, set the pace in the two paths to the turn then gave way while drifting out badly in the stretch.
