7½ FURLONGS. (1274) 85TH RUNNING OF THE DERBY TRIAL. Grade III. Purse \$100,000 FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes in 2009 allowed 2 lbs.; a graded stakes, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Trophy to winning owner. Closed, Wednesday, April 8, 2009 with 40 nominations.

HULL attended the pace three deep, shook clear entering the stretch and widened through the drive. KENSEI settled in hand, launched his bid four wide, failed to menace the winner but continued on willingly to hold the place. CHECKLIST set the pressured pace between horses, weakened during the drive but had enough left to maintain the show. RENDEZVOUS hopped at the start to get away slowly, was unhurried into stride, split horses entering the stretch and improved his position. SILVER CITY disputed the pace along the inside to the stretch and tired. GATO GO WIN stumbled at the start, settled along the inside, waited in traffic leaving the turn, shifted off of the rail entering the stretch, made a mild bid from between horses but failed to sustain the drive. SANTANA SIX was forwardly placed between horses to the stretch and faded. TINTIM POR TINTIM broke in the air to get away behind his field and never recovered.
