By free subscription, \$750 to pass the entry box, \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-Year-Olds, 120 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$100,000 at one mile or over in 2009, allowed 2 lbs.; \$75,000 at one mile or over in 2009, 4 lbs.; \$60,000 at one mile or over in 2009, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Monday May 4, 2009 with 32 nominations.

SKYLIGHTER gained command between rivals nearing the first turn, secured the rail approaching the seven eighths pole, set a slow and rated pace, responded to urging entering the lane, kicked well clear under left handed encouragement in mid stretch then was kept alert through the final sixteenth. UNFORGOTTEN, unhurried early while saving ground, advanced along the rail leaving the far turn, angled out after six furlongs, rallied four wide in upper stretch, drifted out near the sixteenth pole, was straightened away soon after and finished willingly to get the nose bob for the place. ALL SMILES prompted the pace outside the winner, was ridden along leaving the far turn, continued willingly between rivals and just missed the place. TAMMY'S VICTRESS saved ground early, angled out leaving the three quarter pole, moved closer three wide near the half mile pole, angled back to the inside leaving the three sixteenths marker but lacked the needed response. TWO COLUMBUS stalked the early pace off the rail and weakened.
