RAVALO bobbed a stride out of the gate, moved up four wide nearing the half mile marker to reach a stalking position, lodged a three wide bid entering the lane, assumed a short lead in mid stretch, dueled and proved best in an extended drive. SILVER EDITION drifted out some at the break brushing with SPORTY BOY, stalked the pace two wide, lodged a bid between rivals leaving the three sixteenths pole, dueled inside the winner the final sixteenth and just missed in a game effort. CELTIC INNIS chased the early pace three wide, dropped back some near the three eighths pole, shifted out four wide when rallying in upper stretch, loomed boldly a furlong out then hung. GRAND TRAVERSE grabbed the lead at once, set a rated pace along the rail, took pressure into the lane, dueled nearing the eighth pole then faded in the final sixteenth. SPORTY BOY, brushed at the break, chased the pace while saving ground, eased out some in the drive and continued willingly to the wire. AH DAY, bumped at the break, lacked speed while saving ground, angled out for the drive and came up empty. TORPEDO RUN, brushed at the break, came four wide into the lane and failed to threaten.
