By subscription of \$150 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional of \$1,500 when making entry. The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 three times at a mile or over, allowed 3 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 twice at a mile or over, 5 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 once at a mile or over, 7 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 once, 9 lbs. AWESOME RHYTHM, in touch early, moved to the outside early backstretch and closed up outside the leader to force the issue, bid midway through the far turn, vied briefly and drew clear at the top of the stretch, widened under a drive then was taken in hand in the final 70 yards. COUNTER MOVE bobbed slightly leaving the gate, assumed the early lead under restraint, was headed early backstretch, forced the issue from the inside, fell back late turn but finished gamely to gain the place in the late stages. LIFE GOES ON stalked the pace in the early going, moved to the lead early on the backstretch, set a pressured pace, was engaged midturn and cleared at the top of the stretch, chased briefly and evened out late. MENSCH, in touch early along the rail, settled well off the pace, was hustled through the final turn but never reached contention.
