MILWAUKEE APPEAL stalked the pace, launched a fast move on the far turn, challenged alongside TASTY TEMPTATION, was outfooted briefly, vied into the stretch and drove clear then widened under a drive. TASTY TEMPTATION hesitated at the start, was patient then circled the field into the far turn, took command briefly past midturn, was headed at the top of the stretch then chased the winner to the wire to be best of the rest. MISS BLAKELY broke outward, raced in range, chased on the far turn, finished all out and was game to garner third. WYNNING RIDE raced off the pace between rivals, closed late turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch, finished all out but missed third. POLITELYPRECOCIUS, in touch along the rail, was hustled on the far turn, could not stay close to the leaders late turn and evened out. ACADEMICIENNE broke outward, raced well back, closed between fillies late turn and rallied willingly inside. GORE BAY raced off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. SOUL OF NATAKA, well back early, was hustled on the far turn then finished evenly. INDIGO NORTH, in touch early, closed three-wide on the far turn then flattened out midstretch. FIRST CIRCLE, rated in range, gave way late on the backstretch, was hustled six and seven-wide through the turn but lacked a stretch response. SECRET WISH raced off the pace along the rail, was hustled between foes on the far turn then lacked a late response. KOONUNGA HILL, clear quickly, set a reserved pace, was passed midway of the far turn, chased to the stretch and tired. DOUBLE MALT raced off the pace, closed along the rail into the far turn, was in the middle of the pack to the stretch and tired.
