**B. c. (Mar), by A.P. Indy – Eye of the Sphinx, by Smart Strike. Trainer Frostad Mark. Bred by Sam-Son Farm (Ont-C).**

EYE OF THE LEOPARD stalked the pace up close from the outset, chased three-wide into the stretch, drifted out under left-handed urging a furlong out, straightened away and got up in the final strides. MR. FORICOS TWO U forced the pace then took a short lead entering the backstretch, set a pressured pace, extended his lead a bit on the far turn, battled through the stretch with EYE OF THE LEOPARD and gave way grudgingly in deep stretch. MILWAUKEE APPEAL stalked the pace from between horses, was boxed in at the head of the stretch then rallied determinedly when a pathway opened a furlong out. TASTY TEMPTATION stalked the pace, chased four-wide into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. FLIP FOR THE COIN raced in the middle of the pack in the early going, was hustled four then five-wide late on the far turn then evened out in the final furlong. KEINO WEST, off a step slowly, raced well off the pace, angled out closing on the far turn, came six-wide into the stretch and closed a gap but failed to threaten. SHUT IT DOWN, well back early, closed from the third path to five-wide on the far turn, chased into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. RAPID RELEASE, in touch, raced three-wide on the far turn, was still in range at the top of the stretch but flattened out in the final furlong. STARDUST ZIGGY was well back early, angled out on the far turn, was roused five-wide late turn but never reached contention. BUCEPHALUS well back early, raced on the second path, was roused late turn but lacked a strong closing response. RESERVOIR led early, was headed entering the backstretch, forced the issue to the far turn, gave way a little, chased to the stretch and tired. ACTIVE DUTY, in touch early, dropped back to the middle of the pack on the far turn, chased to the stretch and tired. EL BRUJO stalked the pace to the far turn, backed away but was under a ride to the stretch then tired a furlong out.
