All starters to receive a \$2,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any horse that competes in both the Suburban Handicap and Whitney Handicap will have their subscription fees waived for the Whitney Handicap. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, June 20, 2009 with 31 Nominations.

DRY MARTINI was outrun early, saved ground while far back for a half, worked his way forward along the rail leaving the far turn, waited briefly for room while rallying on the rail nearing the quarter pole, split horses entering the stretch, swung out in midstretch then closed steadily under right hand urging to win going away. ASIATIC BOY (ARG) was well placed along the inside for much of the way, saved ground while gaining on the turn, made a run to threaten in midstretch and finished well to hold the place. RISING MOON was outrun along the inside for six furlongs, moved out midway on the turn, circled five wide into the stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. FINALLYMADEIT set a clear pace along the inside for six furlongs, shook loose on the turn, led into midstretch and yielded grudgingly. READY'S ECHO lunged in the air at the start, raced well back for seven furlongs, swung five wide at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. STUD MUFFIN raced in the middle of the pace, awaited room while saving ground on the turn, made a run along the inside to threaten in midstretch and flattened out late. IT'S A BIRD was well placed just behind the winner for a mile and steadily tired thereafter. COOL COAL MAN stalked three wide, lodged a mild bid on the turn then faltered in the stretch. REAL MERCHANT (CHI) raced in midpack between rivals and gave way on the turn. SAMHOON raced wide throughout and gave way.
