BRIDGETOWN broke alertly but outward and was taken in hand, stalked the pace, closed late turn, bid upper stretch and moved clear then held sway under a hand ride. BECKY'S KITTEN raced off the pace, angled from the second path to four-wide late turn then rallied gamely between horses. FANTASTICO ROBERTO (IRE) raced off the pace, came five-wide through the turn and rallied willingly outside. MOBIL UNIT forced the pace in hand, stalked on the turn and was all out through the stretch. STORMY LORD held a short lead on the backstretch, moved clear along the rail into the turn, set a reserved pace but yielded when challenged upper stretch and chased to the end. KORVETTE KID, in touch between foes, angled from the second path to five-wide late turn, chased upper stretch but lacked a strong closing response. YESNABAY, off a step slowly, was extremely rank, pulling hard through the backstretch, was kept in touch between rivals on the turn but flattened out in the stretch. BENESTAR, in touch early, raced four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but tired in the late stages. RUHTRO stalked from the rail, was set down at the top of the stretch, chased, but had no response in the final furlong. PERSONAL SIGNAL raced off the pace, angled from four-wide to six-wide on the turn then lacked a response in the stretch.
