KODIAK KOWBOY was outrun along the inside on the backstretch, saved ground while launching his bid on the turn, angled between horses in upper stretch then finished with a flourish while drifting out a bit to get up in the final twenty yards. FABULOUS STRIKE pressed the pace from outside for a half, made a run to challenge leaving the quarter pole, opened a clear advantage in midstretch, led into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. MUNNINGS moved to the outside in the early stages, stalked along the backstretch, lodged a mild three wide move on the turn and lacked a strong closing response. GO GO SHOOT rushed up along the rail to gain the early advantage, set the pace along the inside into upper stretch and gave way.
