1 MILE. (1.321) 138TH RUNNING OF THE CHAMPAGNE. Grade I. Purse \$400,000 FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$4,000 to pass the entry box. All starters will receive a \$2,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. The New York Racing Association to add The Champagne Challenge Cup, to be won three times, not necessarily consecutively, by the same owner before becoming his or her property. The owner of the winner will also receive a trophy for permanent possession and trophies will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. The winning horse will receive a free nomination to the 2010 Triple Crown. Closed Saturday, September 26, with 30 Nominations.

HOMBOYKRIS was well placed just behind the leaders for a half, edged closer while three wide on the turn, kept ASPIRE trapped along the inside in upper stretch, made a run to challenge inside the furlong marker, took the lead leaving the sixteenth pole and edged clear under steady left hand urging. DISCREETLY MINE pressed the pace from outside for a half, edged closer on the turn, took the lead leaving the quarter pole, battled gamely into midstretch and yielded grudgingly. ASPIRE settled just off the early pace along the inside, saved ground behind the leaders leaving the turn, was boxed in at the three-sixteenths pole, altered course to the outside to get clear in midstretch and rallied belatedly. SUPER SAVER set the pace under pressure along the rail to the top of the stretch, fought heads apart into midstretch and weakened late. DUBLIN was reserved for a half, drifted five wide at the quarter pole then lacked a strong closing response. OVERLAP trailed along the rail throughout.
