COMMENT: Cacique continues surging to the top of the U.S. rankings on turf with perhaps his best performance yet. Whereas he's shown speed before, this time he sat well off very slow splits, bided his time, found room inside into the lane, and blasted home to win going away with a sensational sub-11-second final furlong. Go Deputy likewise sat well back, swung out into the lane to try and go with the winner, but couldn't keep up. Showing Up, facing elders for the first time, stalked the pace comfortably and looked like he might take command heading into the lane, but Cacique was always traveling best. Showing Up couldn't withstand Cacique's charge and then just missed holding second. Still, it was a strong first run vs. elders. Relaxed Gesture was last early and put in only a modest run, looking not at all like the horse that should have won the Grade 1 Manhattan here a few months ago.
