1^{1/8} MILES. (1:39) 56TH RUNNING OF THE SAN FERNANDO. GRADE II. PURSE \$200,000 (includes \$100,000 BC - Breeders' Cup) FOR FOUR-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$200 each to accompany the nomination or by supplementary nomination of \$4,000 at time of entry. \$2,000 additional to start with \$100,000 guaranteed, and an additional \$100,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host associations's money to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Breeders' Cup fund monies also correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup fund monies not awarded will revert to the fund. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$90,000 twice at one mile or over in 2007-08, allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$90,000 at one mile or over in 2007-08 or \$60,000 at any distance since December 25, 4 lbs.; a race of \$45,000 since July 1, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing with preference given to Breeders' Cup nominees only of equal racing quality or weight assignment (respective of sex and weight for age). A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed with 23 nominations.

AIR COMMANDER pulled his way between horses then stalked off the rail, bid outside the runner-up to take the lead in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. JOHNNY EVES sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, fought back through the stretch and was coming back on at the winner through the final sixteenth. TIAGO three deep on the first turn, chased outside then alongside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. RAVEL settled inside chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail then went between horses on the second turn and could not offer the necessary response. SAHARA HEAT four wide early, was bumped nearing the first turn, angled in and stalked off the rail or outside, was a bit off the inside on the second turn, found the fence in the stretch and lacked a rally. GREAT HUNTER settled off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and improved position. MONZANTE pulled his way between rivals and was bumped and steadied into the first turn, stalked between foes, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. HURRY UP AUSTIN unhurried outside a rival for six furlongs, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. SMOOTH AND SAVVY four wide into the first turn, chased outside, went four wide again on the second turn and was not a threat. FRANK THE BARBER angled in and chased a bit off the rail, came out on the backstretch, went between foes on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. BIG BAD LEROYBROWN broke outward and awkwardly, stalked the pace inside, dropped back leaving the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
