1 MILE. (1.33<sup>1</sup>) 28TH RUNNING OF THE SAN RAFAEL. Grade III. Purse \$150,000 FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$150 each to accompany the nomination or by supplementary nomination of \$3,000 by time of entry. \$1,500 additional to start with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to first, \$30,000 to second, \$18,000 to third, \$9,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. \*Early bird nominees to the 2008 Santa Anita Derby (Closing Date Thursday, December 13, 2007) are automatically eligible to the San Rafael Stakes with all fees waived. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$70,000 at one mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; \$40,000 at any distance, 6 lbs. Total earnings in non-claiming races will be used in determining the preference of horses with equal weights. Starters to be named through the entry box by the closing time of entries. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed with 166 early and zero late nominations.

EL GATO MALO pulled his way along inside then a bit off the rail under a rating hold, moved up on the second turn, came out into the stretch, swept to the front past the eighth pole and drew off under a crack of the whip and a brisk hand ride. INDIAN SUN settled outside a rival then along the inside, came out nearing midstretch and gained the place late. MASSIVE DRAMA pulled outside a rival then took the lead and angled in on the first turn, set a pressured pace inside, inched away leaving the second turn, shortened stride some in the stretch and while no match for the winner in the final furlong, lost second late. SIERRA SUNSET stalked off the rail then bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. TALK OF A CAT pulled his way to the early lead inside, came off the rail on the first turn and pressed the pace outside a rival then between foes, drifted to the inside in the stretch and also weakened. OVERBID hopped slightly in a bit of a slow start, angled in and settled inside then just off the rail to the stretch and lacked a rally.
