BEST MINISTER was taken to rate along the inside, moved up in hand nearing the far turn, angled three wide, rallied in hand mid way on the final turn, eagerly pulled clear in upper stretch then edged away under a drive. DURING angled outside of PROSPECT'S THUNDER when that one cleared entering the backstretch, prompted the pace two wide, moved to a short lead leaving the three furlong marker, dueled into the lane then continued gamely to hold the place. PENOBSCOT BAY, unhurried early while well off the pace, steadily advanced four to five wide nearing the lane, continued well to the sixteenth pole, flattened out and was outfinished for the place. SKY SOLDIER angled outside early, stalked the pace three wide to the far turn then dropped back. PROSPECT'S THUNDER went clear into the backstretch and angled to the inside, set the pace to the far turn, dueled around the final turn then faltered entering the stretch.
