KEAGAN, unhurried early and four wide, began closing the gap soon after entering the far turn, coasted to the leaders entering the upper stretch, engaged front-running SKY DIVING leaving the furlong grounds, reached the front about the sixteenth pole and was hard ridden the remainder. SKY DIVING forced the pace around the first turn while four abreast, gained a slight edge, alternated briefly for the lead upon going a half with ROCK CREEK PASS while outside that one, gained a clear advantage on the far turn, made the pace to the final sixteenth and couldn't handle KEAGAN in the late going while superior to the others. SOFT SEVENTEEN hopped slightly when breaking sluggishly, was outrun to the far turn four wide, worked his way out farther on the track when straightened for the drive, reached easy striking distance at the eighth pole but failed to continue. HEY SLICK leaned in after the start exchanging several bumps with TOP AUTHORITY, was outrun four wide into the backstretch, made a run around the far turn to reach contention, maneuvered out six wide into the stretch but was empty the last eighth. WAIT IN LINE contested the pace from early on while between rivals three abreast, was asked for more midway on the far turn, remained a forward factor to the stretch and tired. ROCK CREEK PASS attended the pace from early on while near the inside between horses, battled on even terms, briefly reached the front approaching the end of the backstretch, lost the advantage to SKY DIVING, continued in contention until the final quarter and weakened thereafter. TOP AUTHORITY came out just after the start exchanging several bumps with HEY SLICK, was used soon after contesting the pace inside, was finished leaving the backstretch, then was eased at the furlong grounds when hopelessly beaten.
